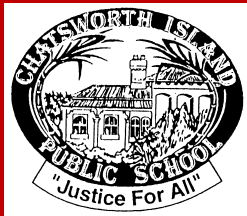

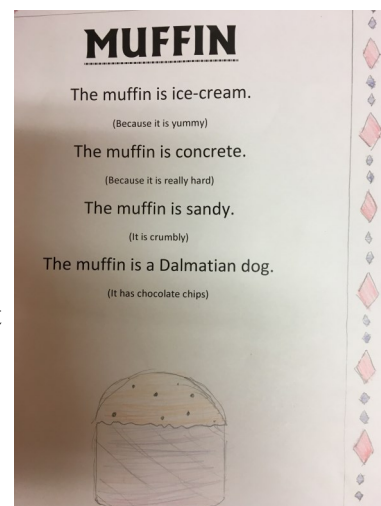
P & C SCHOOL DISCO: A school disco for all students will be held on Thursday December 8 at the Chatsworth Island Community Hall. More information to come.

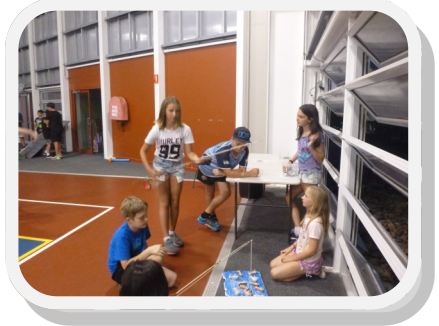
