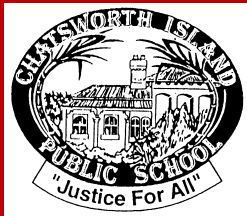

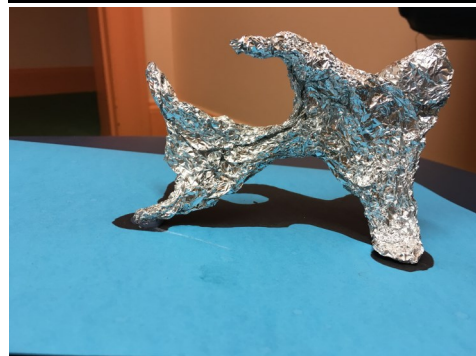
ASHBY DRUMMING PERFORMANCE, SUNDAY SEPT 11:

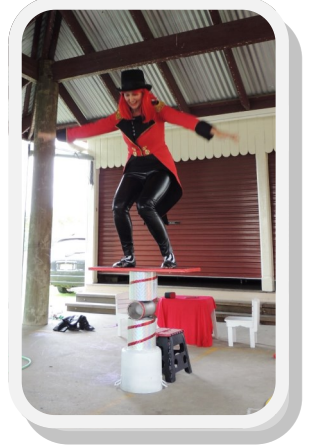

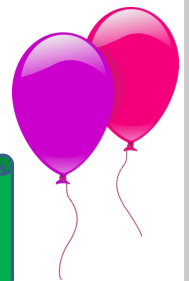
