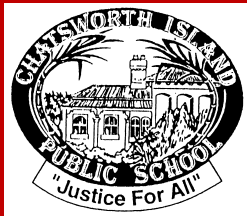

1. **Direct deposits** - As of August 25 we will no longer accept direct deposits into our current school bank account as we prepare to close this account and transition to the new one. Any payments made using direct deposit after this date cannot be properly allocated to a student's account in a timely manner. Please ensure you have made any outstanding direct deposits before August 25.
2. **Cash and cheque payments** - Between August 30 and September 4 we will also not be able to accept payments by cash or cheque as we prepare to close our current bank account and transition to the new one. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding cash or cheque payments before August 30. From September 5, cash and cheque payments will be accepted as before.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we transition to our new finance system.
