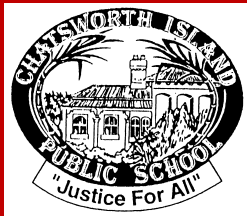

Recently, local Principals were asked to have a consultation surrounding school zones. The following boundaries have always been and will remain in place for Chatsworth Island Public School.

This policy has been developed in accordance with the Department of Education and training document, "Enrolment of Students in Government Schools: A Summary and Consolidation of Policy." It contains the general principles by which students will be enrolled at Chatsworth Island Public School.

Local Area Enrolment.

Children living within the local zone area will be enrolled in accordance with the policies of the NSW Department of Education and Training. Areas served by Chatsworth Island Public School are: The Village of Chatsworth Island, Murrayville Road to Tullymorgan, Jacky Bulbin, Mororo, Woombah to the Bill Weily Bridge, Goodward Island and Tabbimobile.
