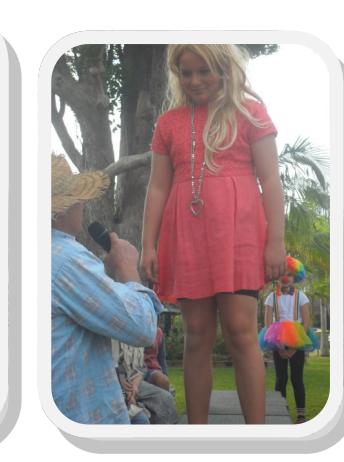
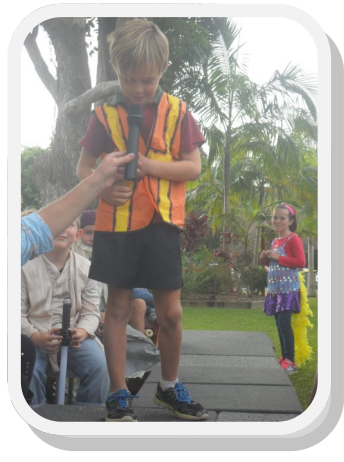
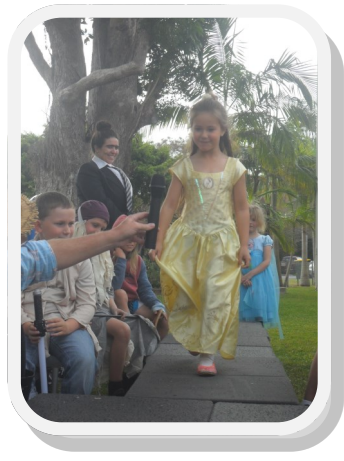
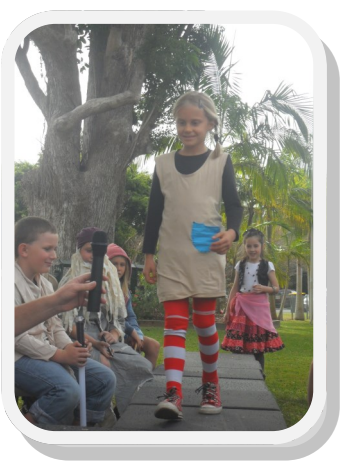
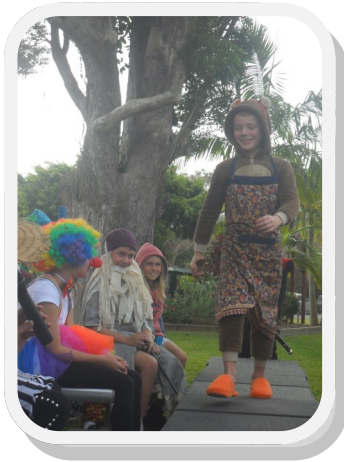
NORTH COAST PRIMARY PRINCIPAL CONFERENCE:
